

2011 Navajo County Rodeo Queen Pageant

We are excited and looking forward to having you take part in this year's Navajo County Rodeo Queen Pageant. This year's theme is *From Back to the Future in Navajo County.*

The NCR queen pageant will take place August 20, 2011 at the Navajo County Fair and Rodeo grounds in Holbrook Az. Starting at 9:00 am.

Pageant Schedule

Horsemanship: The contestant will be given one pattern to complete for horsemanship prior to the competition. Blue Wranglers, White western button up, cowboy hat (any color) and boots (no fashion heel) must be worn.

Private Interview: will take place immediately following horsemanship.

Speech and Modeling: Doors will open at 4:30 pm at the rodeo grounds. Dinner will be served at 5:00 pm. Speech and modeling will take place after dinner. This year's speech topic will be From Back to the future in Navajo County. Queen and Teen Queen will give a 2 minute speech and Princess and Little Buckaroo will give a 1-1 ½ minute speech.

Coronation: 8:00pm our new Navajo County Queens will be crowned.

Entry Fee

All contestants will be required to pay a nonrefundable \$50.00 fee for taking part in the pageant. All Entry forms and fees will be due no later than August 1, 2011.

Program Ad's

All contestants will be required to sell program ads. These ads may be sold to business, or family and friends that want to wish the contestant well. The contestant that sales the most ads will receive a prize at the pageant. Ads need to be turned in no later than August 15, 2011.

Orientation

Orientation will be held July 16, 2011 at 2:00 pm in the Western Grade office located at 1350 Penrod Rd. Show Low AZ. At this time we will be handing out the horsemanship patterns. Orientation is not mandatory but highly recommended. This orientation is meant to better prepare you for your pageant.

Rodeo Queen Clinic

This Clinic is mandatory for all rodeo queen Contestants. The Clinic will include Horsemanship, Modeling, Speech, Appearance, and Private Interview. This will be at the J88 arena in Show Low, AZ on August 6th from 9am-5pm. The cost of this is covered by your entry fee. A Horse must be brought to participate in the clinic. Photos will be taken at this time. These photos will be judged as part of your photogenic category. A western shirt and cowboy hat must be worn.
